Cost of the "Original" Paper The "original" document can be pricey, particularly if it's a unique document. Disadvantages of the "Original" Paper The "original" document can be difficult to obtain. Reporting of "Original" Papers Often times the "original" paper is simply referred to as "the paper", in contrast to the "copy". State of the Art A "state of the art" report (or opinion) is a report written by a forensic document examiner, etc., that assesses the characteristics of a document, article of evidence, etc. to determine whether the document, article. etc., is original or a copy. The opinion is expressed in the form of an opinion (opine) written with a distinct lack of certainty. The opinion can address one or more characteristics of the document, article of evidence. etc., including: The opinion is used as evidence in court. It is an opinion used as evidence. It can be used in court. Approved forensic examiners and specialities must follow the procedures prescribed in the Forensic Science Foundation (FLF) of Australia FSA for Forensic Science Opinions.
